

2026-28 RED WALL LOYALTY SCHEME

The 2026-28 Red Wall Loyalty Scheme will be in place for Cymru men's national team matches up to, and including, UEFA EURO 2028 (subject to qualification). The scheme is exclusively for 2026-28 Red Wall Adult/Junior members, with the purpose of ensuring loyalty is rewarded.



Please note, while this is the intended loyalty scheme for the 2026-28 period, the information contained below is subject to change.

AWAY MATCHES

Tickets from the Red Wall allocation for Cymru away matches will be exclusively available to 2026-28 Red Wall Adult/Junior members on a one ticket per member basis. These will be sold subject to the Red Wall loyalty scheme, with the amount of previous booking history required varying dependant on the total allocation size. Supporters qualifying in Stage 1 will require **X** of the previous away matches on their booking history and will usually be guaranteed a ticket provided they book before stage 1 closes. Supporters qualifying in stage 2 will require **X-1** of the previous away matches on their booking history, **X-2** matches will be required in stage 3, and so on until either tickets sell out or sales close. To protect the integrity of the loyalty scheme, ticket collections will be in place for away matches and supporters who fail to collect may be placed in the final stage for future matches.

2026/27 UEFA NATIONS LEAGUE

The following matches will form the basis of the loyalty scheme for away matches during the 2026/27 UEFA Nations League campaign:

Away matches already played within the Nations League campaign will also be considered if tickets for a match are put on sale after the previous fixture(s) has taken place.

EURO 2028 QUALIFYING

The following matches will form the basis of the loyalty scheme for away matches during the EURO 2028 Qualifying campaign:

- All Cymru away matches from the 2026/27 UEFA Nations League
- Romania v Cymru 06.06.2026
- Liechtenstein v Cymru 15.11.2025
- England v Cymru 09.10.2025
- Kazakhstan v Cymru 04.09.2025
- Belgium v Cymru 09.06.2025
- North Macedonia v Cymru 25.03.2025

Away matches already played within the EURO 2028 campaign, including any away friendly matches (if any) played during the period, will also be considered if tickets for a match are put on sale after the previous fixture(s) has taken place.

HOME MATCHES

CAMPAIGN TICKETS

Campaign tickets, covering all group matches during the qualification campaign, will be available exclusively to 2026-28 Red Wall Adult/Junior members on a one Campaign Ticket per member basis.

Supporters who held a Campaign Ticket for the 2026 World Cup qualification campaign, will have the opportunity to renew their seats (provided they have a 2026-28 Red Wall membership).

HOME MATCHES – FRIENDLIES AND MATCHES INCLUDED IN THE CAMPAIGN TICKET

2026-28 Red Wall Adult/Junior members will be able to purchase tickets during a priority window for all Cymru men's home matches. During this window, tickets will be sold on a first come first served basis. The only way to guarantee tickets for all Cymru competitive home matches is by purchasing a Campaign Ticket.

HOME MATCHES – COMPETITIVE MATCHES NOT INCLUDED IN THE CAMPAIGN TICKET

Campaign ticketholders will have the opportunity to renew their seats for any competitive matches not covered by the Campaign Ticket (e.g. play-offs). *In the event that seat renewal is not possible, Campaign Ticket holders will have a priority window to purchase tickets before they go on sale to all Red Wall members.*

Following the renewal period, the Red Wall priority window will open for 2026-28 Red Wall Adult/Junior members without a Campaign Ticket, as well as Campaign ticketholders who would like to change seats or purchase additional tickets.

EURO 2028 FINALS TOURNAMENT

As for previous tournaments, should Cymru qualify for EURO 2028, we expect a ticket allocation to be available for The Red Wall for Cymru matches. This allocation will be available exclusively to Red Wall members and will be sold subject to the Red Wall loyalty scheme. With matches being held in Cymru, we expect demand to be extremely high.

As tickets for the tournament will be sold through UEFA, the following loyalty scheme is dependent on the structure of the sales process and is subject to change.

The following points-based system will be used when determining priority.

Important: Tickets should be assigned to an account at the point of purchase – it will not be possible to do this retrospectively. Transferring a ticket to a Red Wall member via the Cymru Tickets app will not add that match to their booking history.

Previous booking history can be found by logging into your account at www.faw.cymru/tickets and viewing your 'Account History'. You can only earn points for each match once, regardless of how many tickets are purchased.

RED WALL MEMBERSHIP – 3 POINTS EACH

- 2026-28 Red Wall Adult/Junior Membership – **REQUIRED**
- 2024-26 Red Wall Adult/Junior Membership

CAMPAIGN TICKETS – 4 POINTS EACH PLUS 1 POINT PER MATCH (SEE 'HOME MATCHES' BELOW)

- 2026-27 Campaign Ticket
- 2024-25 Campaign Ticket

Half campaign tickets (purchased after the Nations League) are worth 2 points each plus 1 point per match covered. Note, half Campaign Tickets are sold subject to availability.

HOME MATCHES – 1 POINT EACH

Cymru men's home matches played between the start of the 2026 World Cup qualifying campaign (Cymru v Kazakhstan, 22.03.2025) and the end of the EURO 2028 qualifying campaign (group stage) will be worth one point each. This includes any home friendly matches played in that period.

If Cymru are involved in EURO 2028 home play-off matches, these may also be included (sales timeline dependent).

AWAY MATCHES – 2 POINTS EACH

Cymru men's away matches played between the start of the 2026 World Cup qualifying campaign (North Macedonia v Cymru, 25.03.2025) and the end of the EURO 2028 qualifying campaign (group stage) will be worth two points each. This includes any away friendly matches played in that period.

If Cymru are involved in EURO 2028 away play-off matches, these may also be included (sales timeline dependent).
